

### **Message From the Executive Director**

While we live in one of the best places on the planet to grow up, we also face daily crises in the treatment of children. Causes of abuse continue to range from untreated mental illness, to substance use, to histories of violence that carry forward through parenting and bullying. Fortunately, our community got stronger in its response to the challenges facing our children. This year brought so many great accomplishments for children in Orange County:

- Our community's professionals continued to strengthen their understanding of trauma-informed practices that allow us to align our support for children who carry a history of tragic events.
- Our faith-based communities, youth organizations, and schools continued to increase their capabilities in screening, educating, and appropriately reacting to the potential for child abuse.
- Academia is making great gains in understanding the biological, psychological and sociological effects of child abuse...and factors that contribute to it too...that can help us practically identify families and children who need help and align our responses.

At CAPC, we continue to encourage advances and apply new thinking to the practical help given to our families and children. A very brief summary of accomplishments include:

- Helping over 7,000 children and parents build a more stable home environment through our direct inhome programs. Our programs bring help to where the need is...in the homes of our at-risk families.
- Expanding our Children's In-Home Crisis Stabilization Program to serve over 600 at-risk children and their families.
- Opening up to the whole county our School Readiness program that helps families faced with challenging young children to prepare them for school.
- Increasing our community collaborations and partnerships to cover more cities within Orange County.
- Connecting over 450 at-risk families to our volunteers, corporate teams, and donor families through our three Families Helping Families events.



While we continue to work tirelessly to meet the immediate needs of our children and families, our long-term focus is on the families of the next 50 years: working together as a community to eventually end child abuse in Orange County. We cannot achieve this goal without your help. We all need to be a part of the fight against child abuse, and we thank you for your part in breaking the generational cycle of abuse for today's and tomorrow's kids who need us most.

### **Success Story – Infant Program**


Jessica was experiencing post-partum depression and feeling overwhelmed with a new baby in the home in addition to her three other children.

Our Infant In-Home Visitation caseworker Megan began visits with Jessica to improve her relationship with her baby. Megan learned during her visits that the father had a drinking problem, which caused marital problems, like controlling behavior towards his wife. In addition to working with mother and baby, Megan referred Jessica to our Well Program's in-home mental health services. After a few weeks, Jessica's newfound confidence prompted her to encourage her husband to stop drinking, and Megan referred them both to counselling and support groups. The father stopped drinking, became more caring towards his family, and he began to help Jessica with the children. Jessica was now holding, playing with, and reading to her baby, and providing her other children with the love and




### **Financial Highlights**

We value every child's right to grow up in a safe and nurturing home environment.

### At A Glance

The Orange County Child Abuse Prevention Center is the largest nonprofit organization in Orange County focused solely on the prevention of child abuse. We are an organization of 135 staff members, 400 volunteers, and 15 programs—all of which have a well-documented record of strengthening parent-child relationships and preventing abuse before it occurs.

Our programs bring parent education, mental health and counseling, and family support services directly to families at risk of child abuse and neglect. The single most distinguishing feature of our services is the emphasis on intensive in-home parent education and care. Our service model is based on research by the U.S. Advisory Board on Child Abuse and Neglect that endorses in-home support as the most effective approach to successfully preventing child maltreatment. Preventionfocused services are proven to save our community \$5.70 to \$20 for every prevention dollar spent.

### Success Story – Parent Program

### Alliance for Children and Families

The Child Abuse Prevention Center is a founding member of the Alliance for Children and Families. The Alliance brings together organizations providing human services to families in its aim to identify gaps in service, set standards for quality, and help the community develop resources to create stable organizations.

### Bridges for Newborns (Infant/Toddler Program)

A partnership between community hospitals and providers like MOMS Orange County, this collaborative brings in-home support to new moms in high-risk situations.



### Outreach & Engagement Collaborative

A collaboration between Orange County Child Abuse Prevention Center, Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Community Alliance, Inc., and Western Youth Services allows assessment and treatment of mild to moderate behavior health conditions across all of Orange County. Services include shortterm case management, support groups, educational workshops, and referrals to community resources.

### SERVE PROGRAMS

"Serve" programs helped bring hope and intensive support to over 5,200 people.

Infant	We serve high-risk families with infants in order to strengthen bonding, attachment, and self-sufficiency
Toddler	We serve high-risk families with toddlers in order to promote positive parenting, positive behavior, and positive relationships
Coach	We serve families suspected of abuse in order to prevent future abuse by coaching families to a healthier place
In-Home Focused	We provide intensive family support services in order to prevent negative parenting patterns and abusive behaviors
In-Home Mental Health	We bring mental health support to isolated parents in order to enable the parent to meet the needs of their children
Crisis Stabilization	We serve suicidal and homicidal children who can't be hospitalized in order to diffuse the crisis, promote a healthy family, and keep the family unit together
Visitation	We serve families who have been separated in order to reconnect the family as a unit in a safe, healthy environment
Child Abuse Services Team (CAST)	We serve child victims of abuse in order to reduce the trauma they experience while their abuse is investigated
Basic Needs	We serve families gaining custody of children in order to provide critically-needed household items

## "I never thought that I could have the chance to become an amazing parent. Through this program, I have implemented so many great techniques to help me understand, learn, react and grow as a parent so that my son can be a healthy young four year old boy.

As a child, I did not have the luxury to be led by example on how to be a parent. Growing up in the foster system and in an abusive home, soon resulted in a vicious cycle of a life I had once lived as a child. When I became a mother, I had no idea what a mother was or how to be one, but because of this program I am excited to reach out and ask for help to learn even more about being a parent.

I never knew how vital it was to teach your child with love and understanding, but most of all with respect. How engaging with eye contact and getting down to my son's level could have such an effect on how he would trust, listen and overall feel towards the world as a child and later on as an adult. Using punishment and spanking is not the right way to discipline or control your child, intimidation is never a tool to utilize. Most of all, I have learned that it is never too late to experience a chance to change and become the parent that everyone strives to be. I am forever grateful to this program because I am able to be a confident mother and to be honest, this was one of my wildest dreams."

The past year has been one of growth for the Child Abuse Prevention Center. Program expansion created further need to rally dedicated supporters and tireless volunteers to our cause.



The fiscal year kicked off with our Summer Celebration event, passing out backpacks and school supplies to children in-need. Our 15th Annual Charity Golf Classic in August brought out business leaders in our community to Monarch Beach for a day on the links.

We rode the Carousel of Possible Dreams at Disneyland, as a part of the Festival of Children, raising almost \$24,000. And, with the help of hundreds of volunteer Santas, Elves and Reindeer, we collected, wrapped, and delivered Christmas gifts to 330 families in dire financial need.









The new year brought prominent businesswomen together for a lively panel discussion during our Annual Women in Balance luncheon. At CampHeART, our program families brought out their little artists to explore new mediums and express themselves in imaginative ways.

April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month, and we capitalized on the opportunity to create further awareness in the community. We visited city council meetings each week, were presented with an award by Cal State Fullerton for our intern program, and were the Premier Charity for Reebok's Ragnar Relay So Cal, where we entered 13 teams of runners and created a presence along the two-day relay course. We capped off the month with our Bright Futures Celebration Derby Party, where over 230 guests helped us raise over \$120,000 during the course of the evening.

It was a fantastic year, and we owe a tremendous thanks to our generous donors and sponsors, our energetic army of volunteers, our dedicated Board of Directors, and our tireless staff for making this fiscal year a success.














### SAVE A CHILD
